This Notice of Application is part of the permit review process. Please review the following information for details about this proposed project and the timelines and process for providing comments.

#### PROJECT

##### Proposed Project Action:

*Apply lime-treated class I, II, and III septage on three (3) sites ("Carbonado Unit", "Guthrie Unit", and "Gleason Hill Unit") within the White River School District Property. Northwest Cascade is working in conjunction with Lusignan Forestry Inc. to evaluate the application methods and effects of on-site, lime-treated septage forest land applications. Treated septage will be applied using a specially designed tanker system. Application may occur multiple times in order to reach the concentration determined by the Washington State Department of Ecology's AAR formula. Septage will arrive on-site in self-contained transport vehicles of a 6,000 gallon capacity. There will be at least one 20,000 gallon holding tank on-site and two mixing tanks (each having 9,000 gallons in holding capacity) that are contained within a single container. The three project sites occupy approximately 1,307 acres and are located in Rural 20 (R20) and Forest Land (FL) zone classifications.*
